Swimming	Shallow and deep swimming areas supervised by lifeguards. Water Mat, Diving Tower, and Quadrapod.	11 AM - 12 PM 1:30 - 5 PM	At the beach in the marked swimming area.	DO NOT SWIM if there is no lifeguard on duty. Lifeguards have final say. Children may not swim without parental supervision.
Boating	Canoes, Kayaks, Row Boats, Paddle Boats, Stand Up Paddleboards, Sailboats	11 AM - 12 PM 1:30 - 5 PM OR if over 18 or with an Adult: Sunrise to BEFORE Sundown	At the Beach and at the boat dock next to the Gathering Place.	Wisconsin Law requires a life jacket for each passenger in the boat. Per Fort's guidelines, everyone 15 & under MUST wear a life jacket and be accompanied by an adult if going in the back bays of Spider Lake (<i>out of view of the Waterfront</i>).
Fishing (Read boating notes)	To fish you must have your own equipment. Please use our watercraft.	11 AM - 12 PM 1:30 - 5 PM	On Spider Lake OR from the Wrangler's Breakfast dock. Do not drive into Blair Lake site or take any boat. Dock fishing only.	DO NOT fish from our swimming dock or near swimming areas on Spider or Blair Lake. Catch & release only. Anyone 16 & over MUST have a Wisconsin fishing license.
Hiking	Breathe deeply of fresh, Northwoods air and adventure into the forest on our beautiful trails.	Sunrise to Sunset	Check out the poster in the Sign-Up Room for details.	Do not use the Stockade 80 trails on Sunday or Thursday as the range is open.
Mountain Biking	Military Trail is 3.6 miles of moderate terrain. Ridge Run is 4.2 miles and is rated difficult. Shotgun Trail is 3.8 miles and is rated difficult.	Monday and Wednesday 11 AM - 9:00 PM	Stockade 80 is 1.3 miles from camp. Turn right onto Spider Lake Rd. #6089 is on the left.	Do not use these trails when Stockade 80 is open (Sun & Thurs afternoons). You provide the bike and transportation to Stockade 80.
Waterslide	Go down on a tube and splash into Spider Lake. Bring a friend and enjoy the ride! For ages 6 and up. 250 lb. limit.	Sunday & Thursday 1:30 - 5:00 Tuesday 3:00 - 5:00	Past the parking lot, up the path that leads to the Amphitheater.
